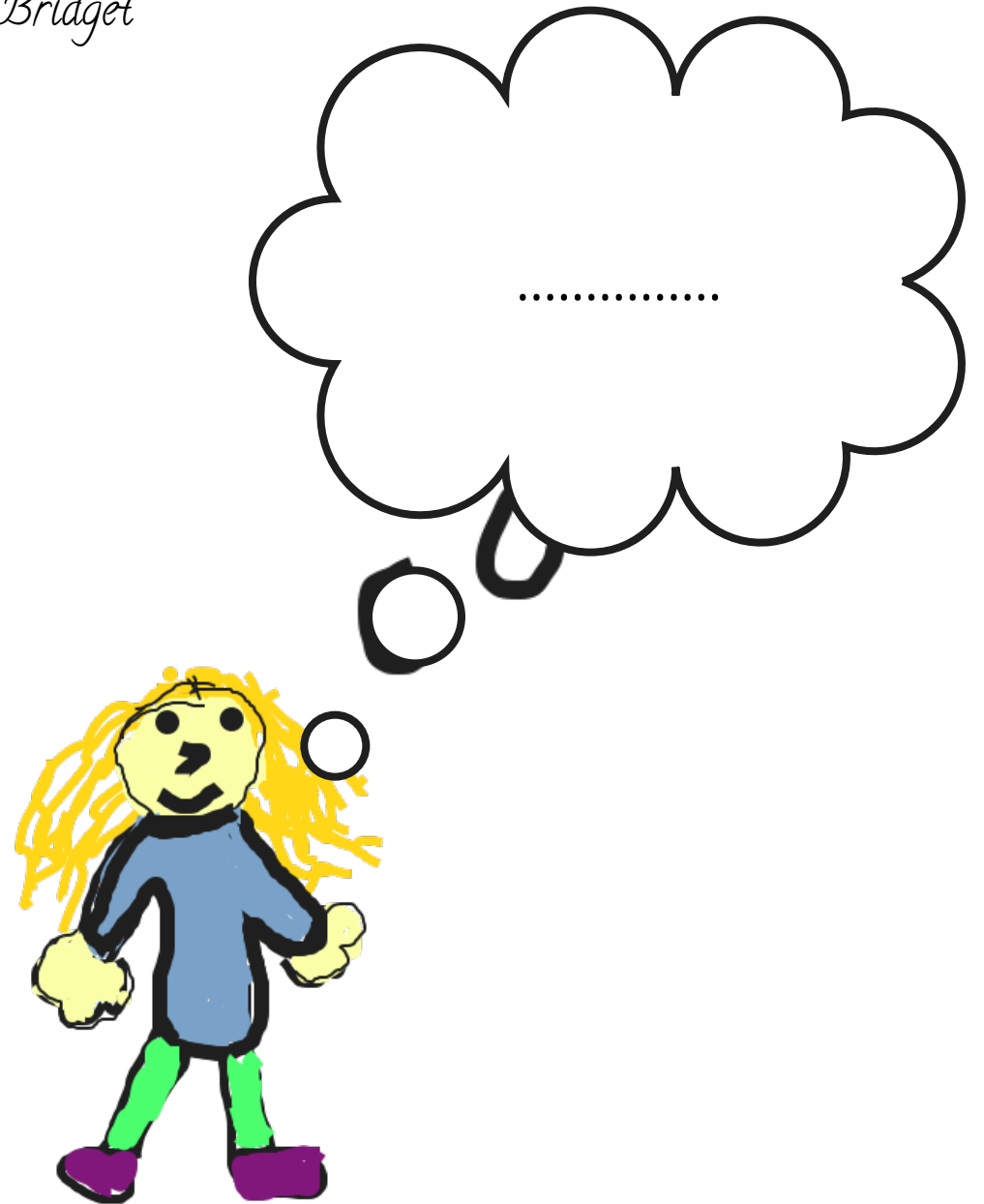


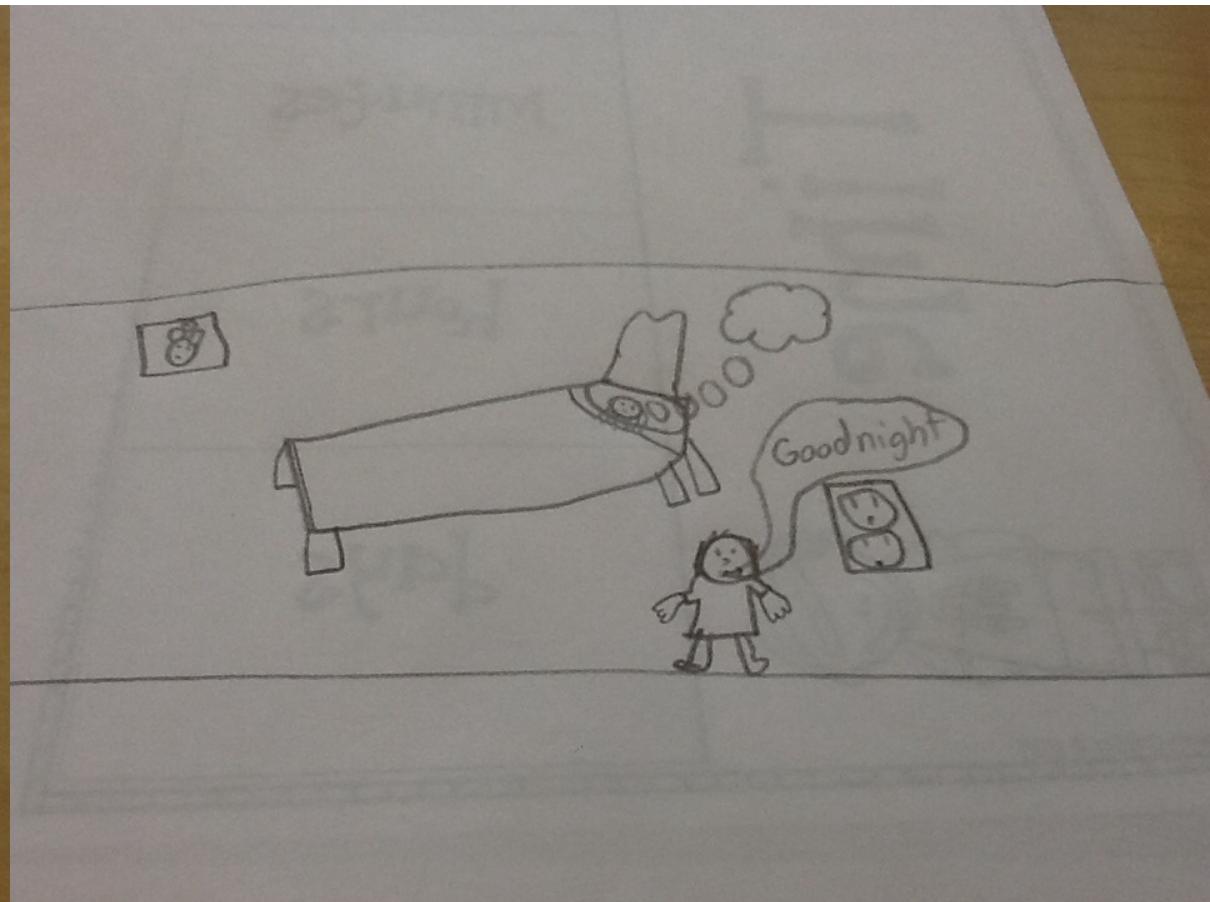
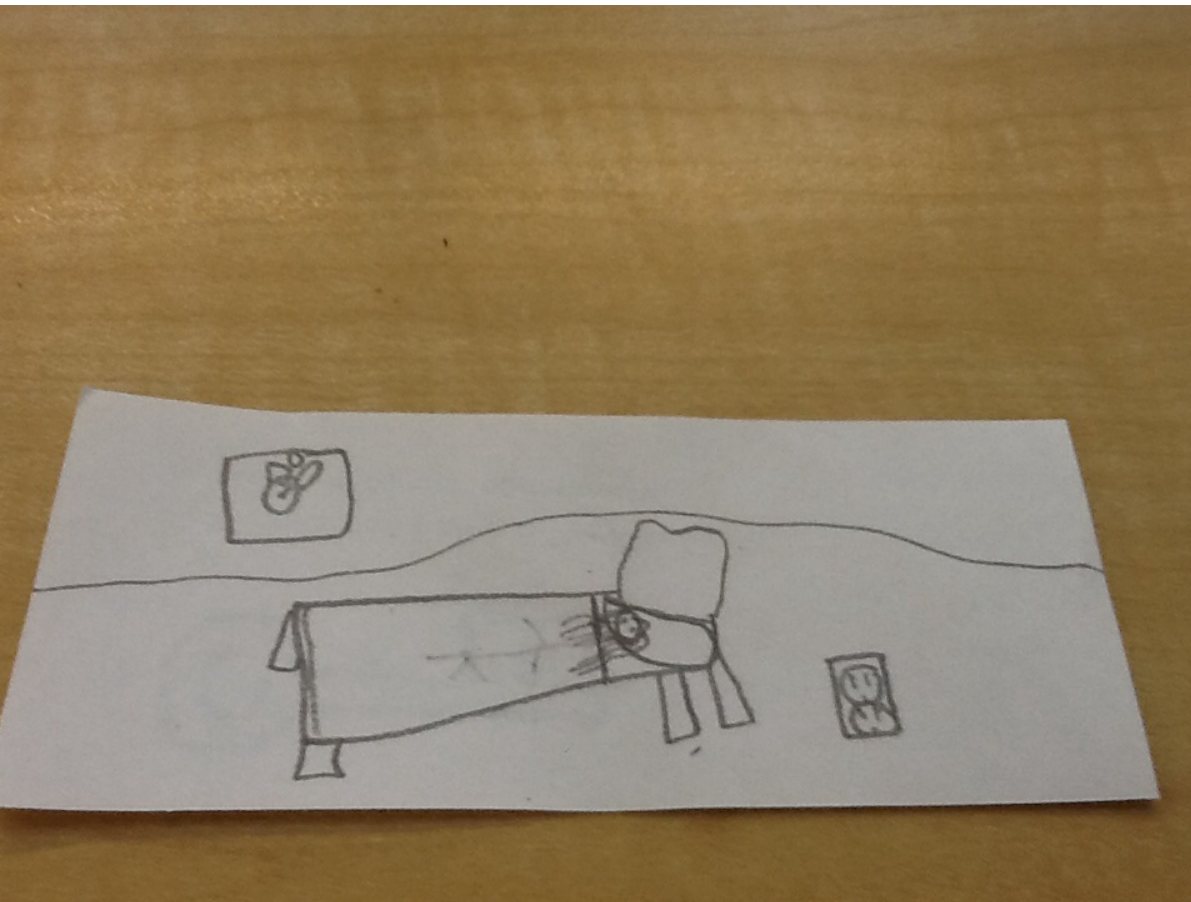
*The Best Idea Ever!*

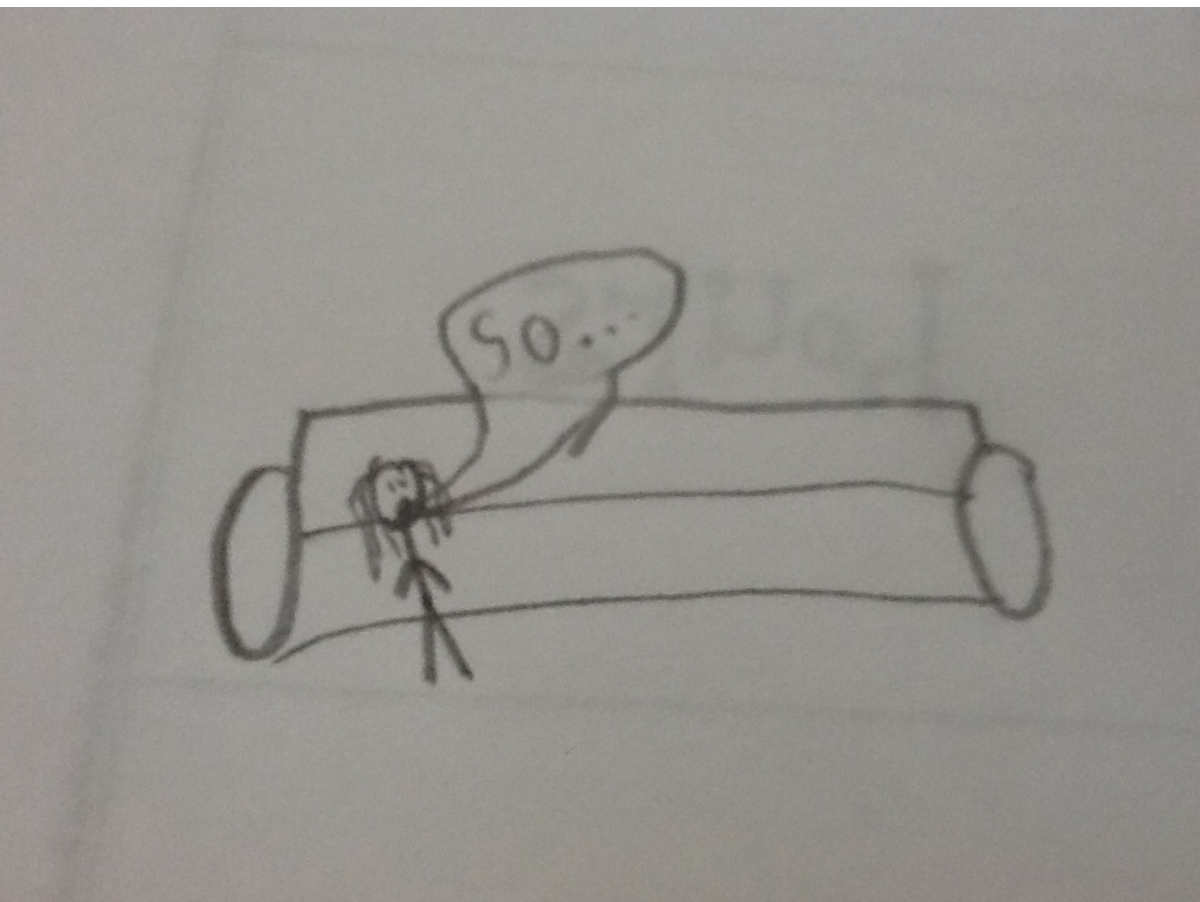
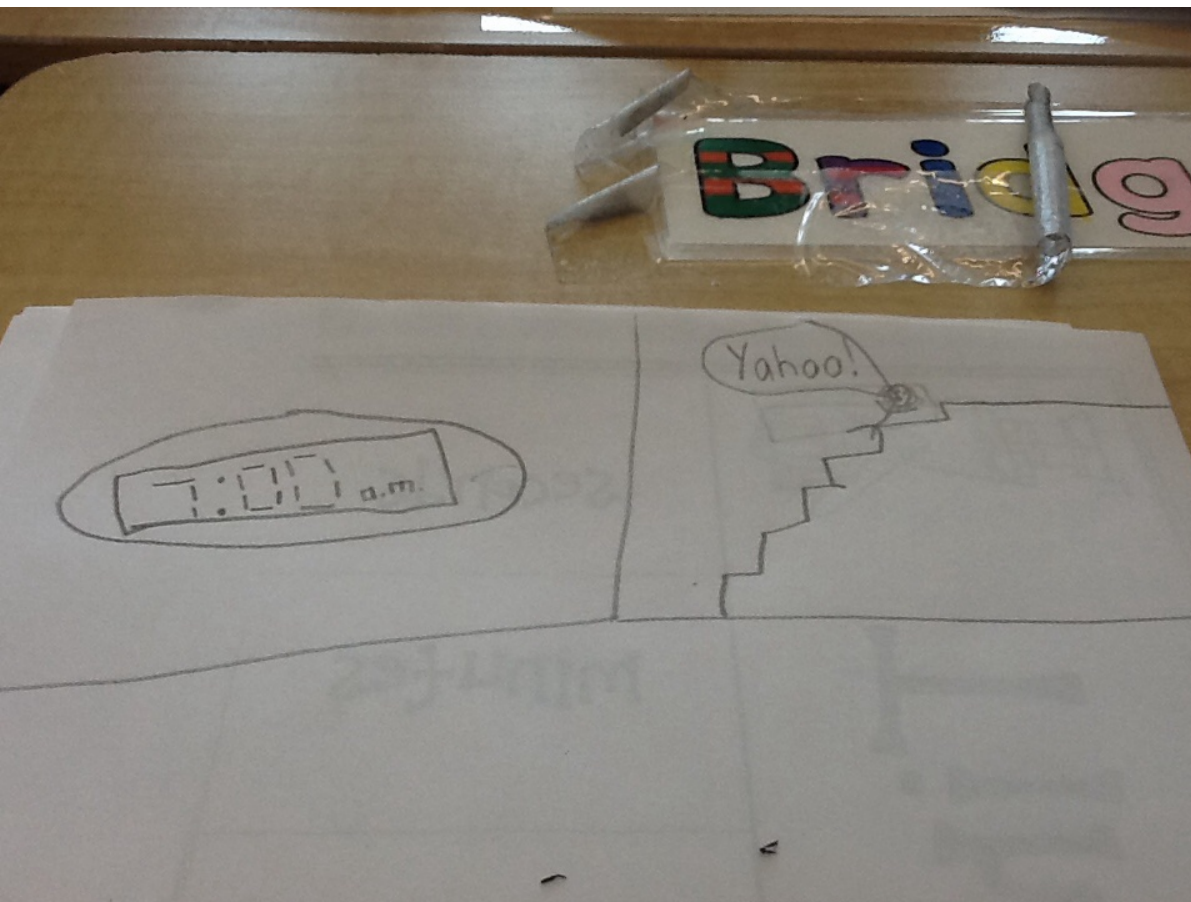
Becca was in her orange, comfy bed. She got warm when she pulled her four, pretty comfy blankets over her.

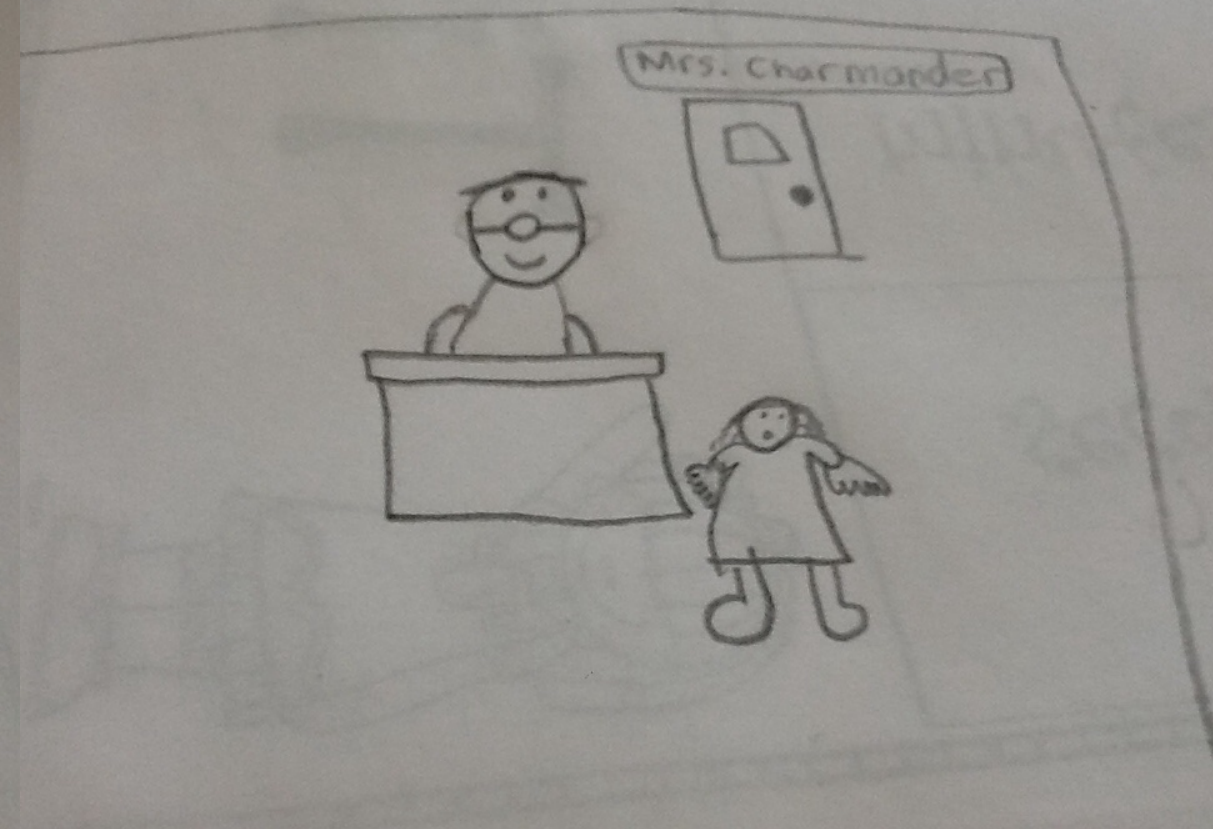
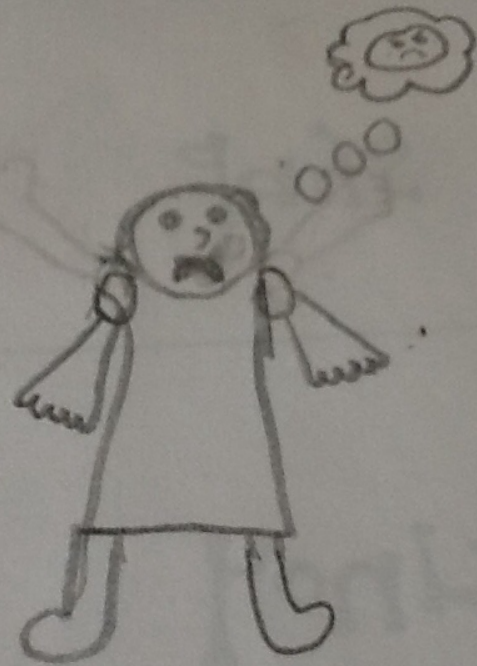
Waiting for her parents to say "Why not," she sat there on the couch smiling and curling back her blonde and curly hair.

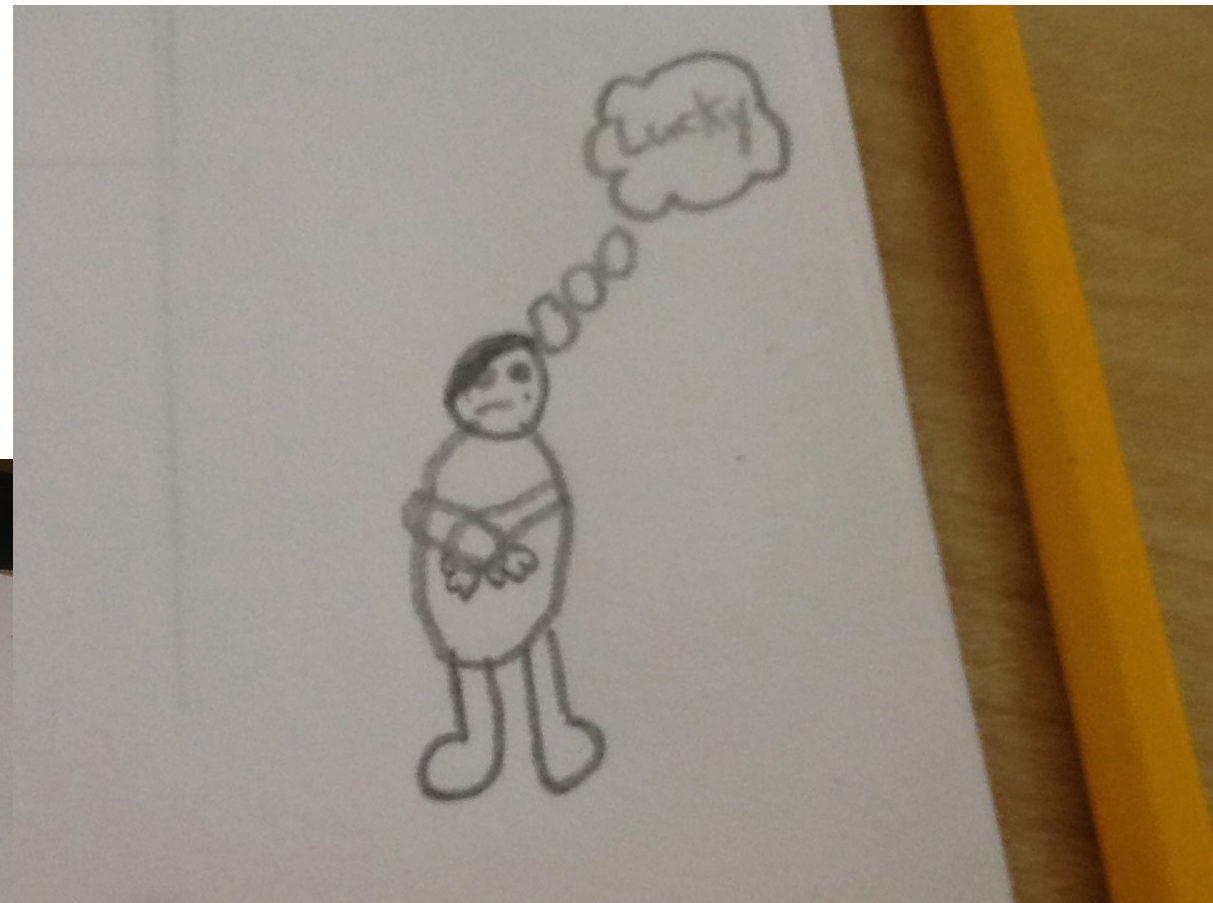
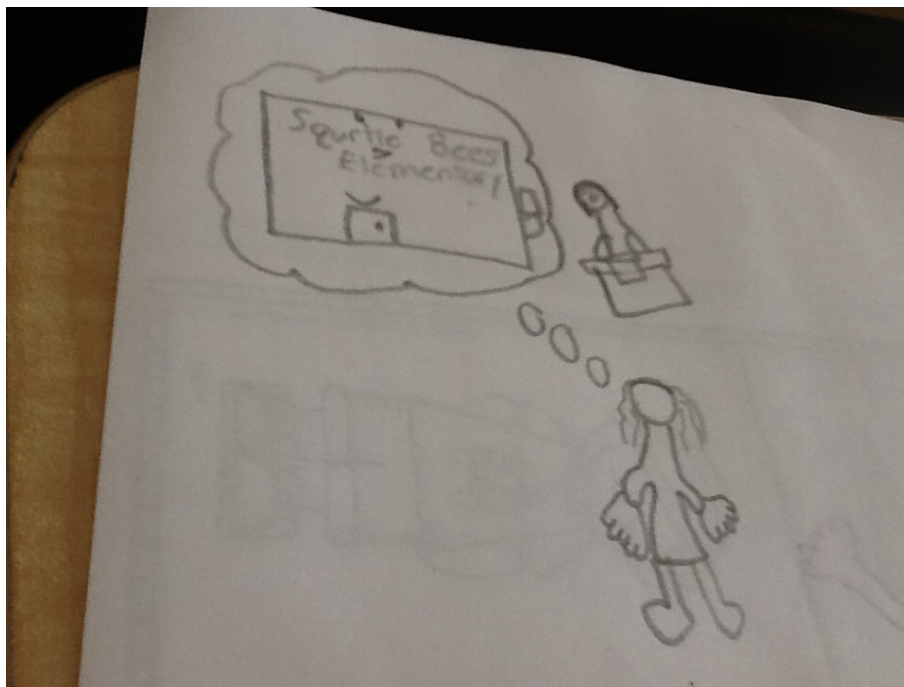
