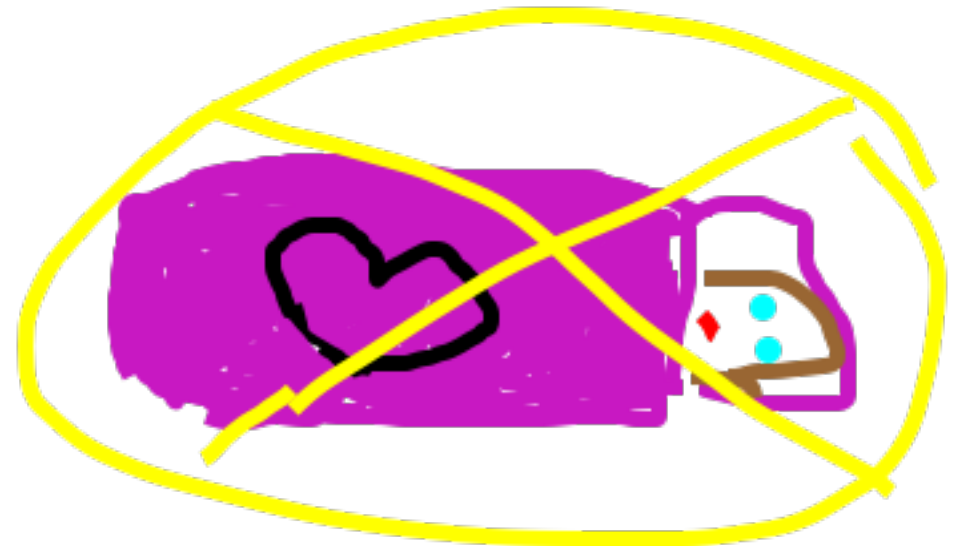


The Fun Sleepover NOT
