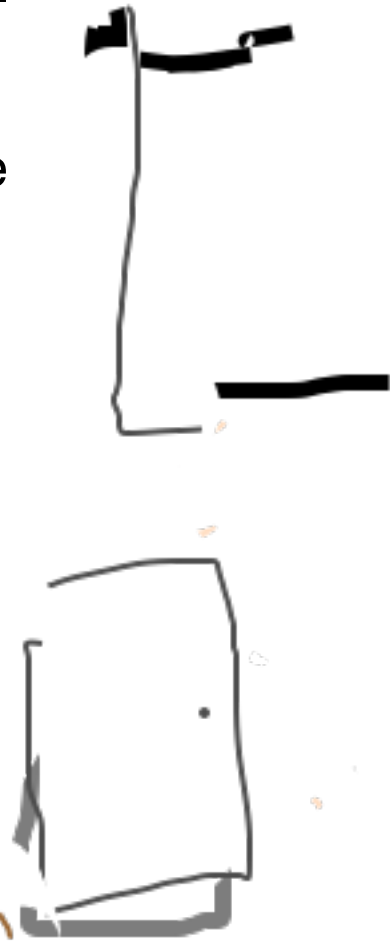


Max Gets The Game

"Look across the street." said the employee. Before you know it Max was already there. "Man I'm glad I'm fast!" Max said to himself.



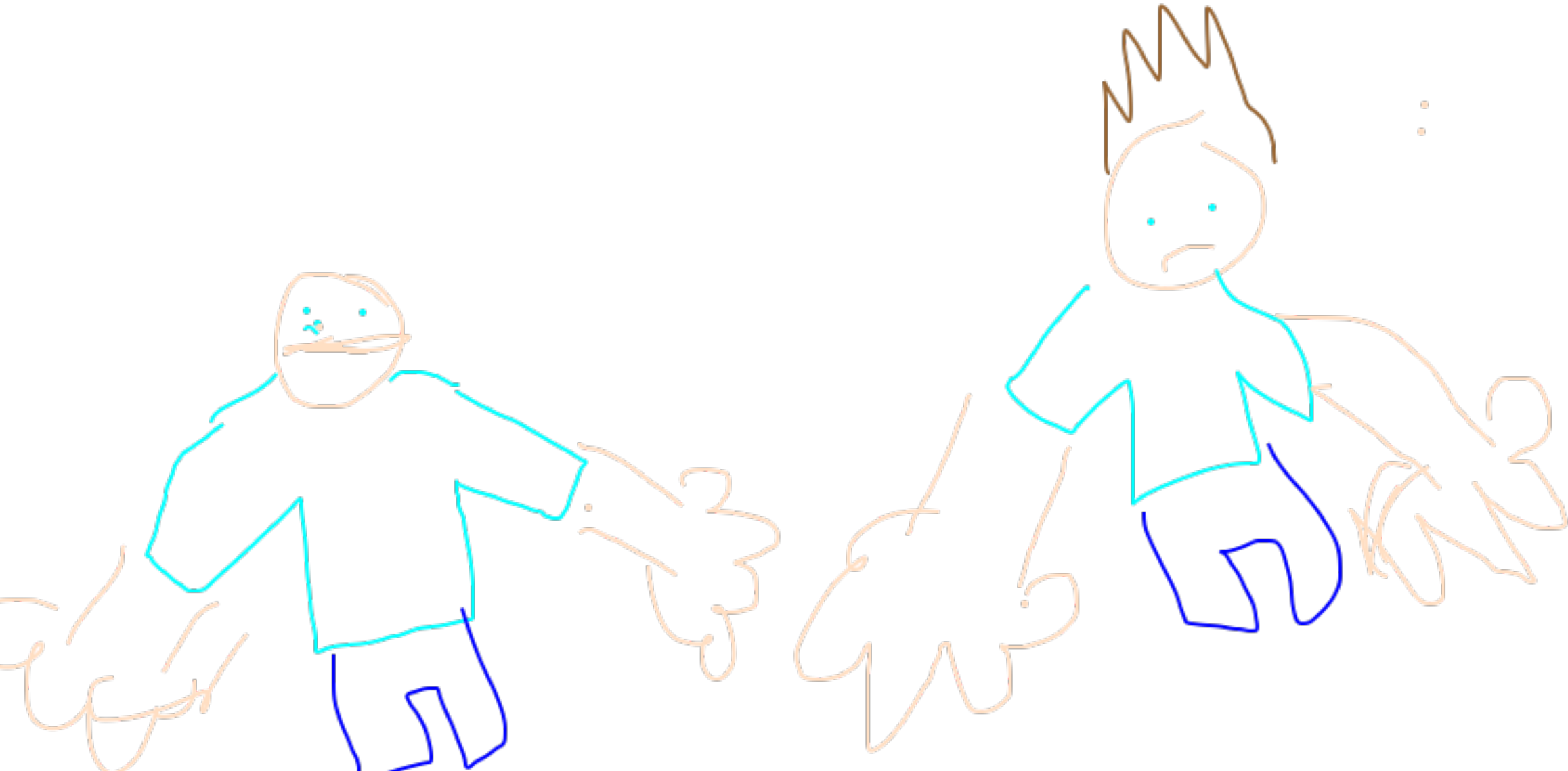
He stopped for a minute then Max swung open the door.

"Huh do do you have Halo...?" "No I'm sorry sir." He looked around and walked away from counter.



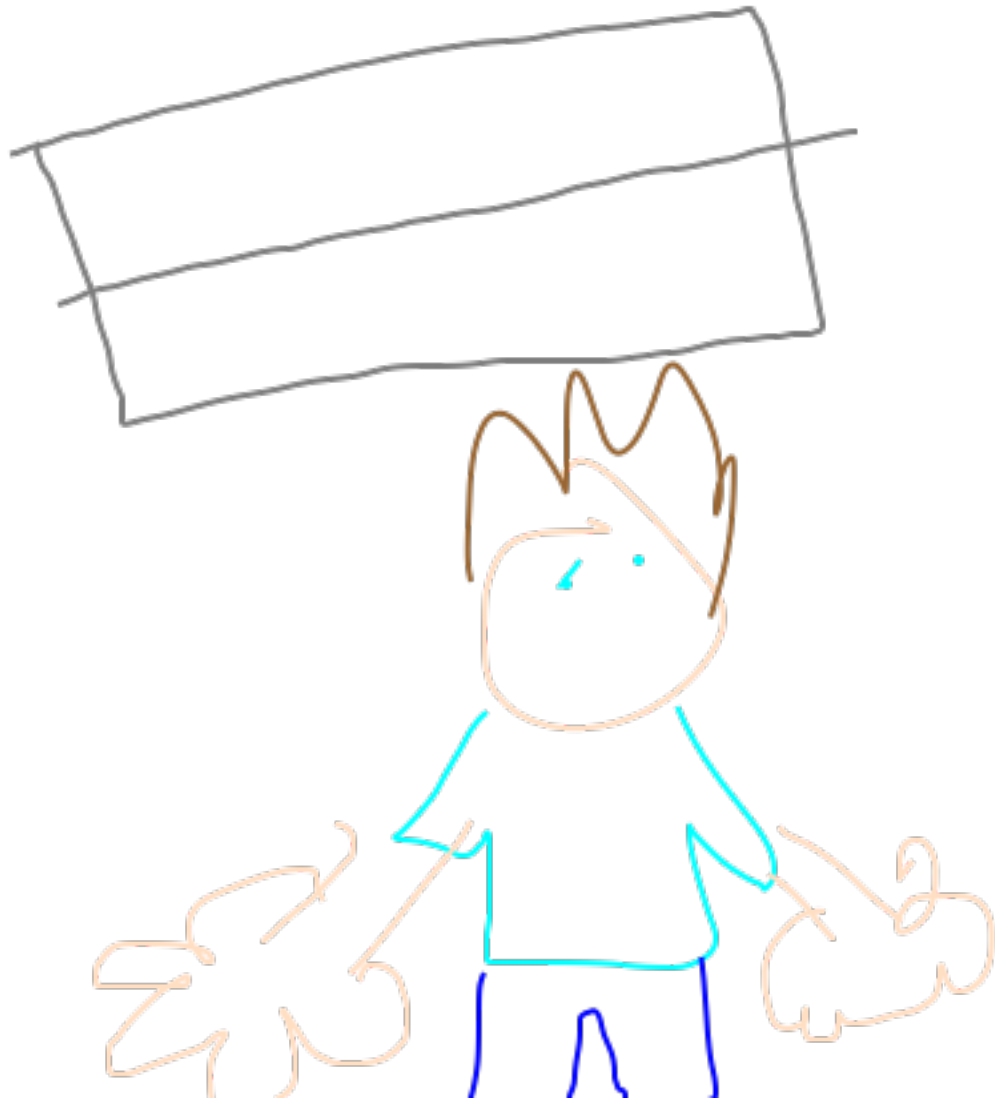
Then he said to himself "I had no idea that Halo was so popular."

Then he looked to the shelf of Halo games.

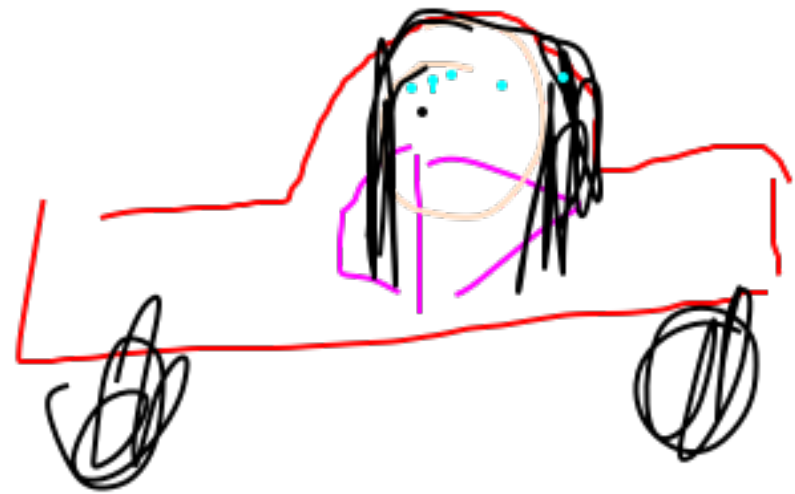
"I think I might get a different game but I don't want a different game." Max said to himself. "Max!" His mom called. "Hold on." he replied.
